

BUNGEE JUMPING IN AZNALCÓLLAR, SEVILLE ¿HOW TO GET THERE BY BUS?

Meeting point

Bridge of Madroñalejo (Puente del Madroñalejo) on the Reservoir of Agrio (Embalse del Agrio), Aznalcóllar (Sevilla).

How to get from Seville to Aznalcóllar.

You have to take the bus line **M-176** "Sevilla - Camas - Gerena - Aznalcollar" inside the bus station "Plaza de Armas" in Seville. It departs on Sundays at **10:00 AM and at 1:00 PM**. Check the updated schedules on the website of the "Consortio de Transportes Metropolitano del área de Sevilla": https://siu.ctas.ctan.es/horarios_lineas_tabla.php?linea=234

The bus usually departs from platform 37-38. The tickets are sold in the bus. The fare is €3.00 / one way. After a 55 minutes trip, we have to get off the bus in the town of Aznalcóllar at the stop "Av. Andalucía (La Farola)".

How to get from Aznalcóllar to the bridge.

To go from the bus stop to the bridge we have two options:

- **By taxi:** The local taxi in Aznalcóllar has 4 seats available. If your group is larger, the cab can make several trips. The cost of the service is about €15. We recommend to **call the day before to book the taxi**. Just tell the driver to take you to the "Puente de Madroñalejo" (Bridge of Madroñalejo), the place where we do "puenting" (bungee jumping).

- **Walking:** (6.3 km / 4 miles - 1 hour 15 minutes approx.). From Aznalcollar we have to go to the "Embalse del Agrio" (Reservoir Agrio), indicated on the road as "Pantano" (Reservoir), always following the road, initially towards "El Castillo de las Guardas", and after 2 km turning to the left towards "El Alamo". After a couple of kilometers, we will reach the "Bridge of Madroñalejo", where we jump. We would like to point out that it can be very hot along the way, especially in summer, so we recommend bringing water and sun protection. Hitchhiking is probably a better option. See map on page 2.

How to come back
